**MoPH notice of proposed awards to successful consultants under PCH  
project**

Kabul, 7 Oct 2009

The Ministry of Public Health (MoPH) of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan has signed an Implementation Letter with USAID through which health services will be provided to the Afghan people through the provision of Basic Package of Health Services (BPHS) in thirteen provinces, Essential Package of Hospital Services (EPHS) in five provinces and Wazir Akbar Khan Support Project (WAKH-SP) through Partnership Contracts for Health Services project (PCH). The procurement of services for PCH project has almost been completed and we are making preparations for signing the contracts with successful bidders.

The MoPH evaluation committees reviewed the technical and financial proposals of all qualified bidders for PCH project and the result of final combined scores and the rankings was announced to all bidder NGOs. MoPH completed the negotiations with first rank qualified bidders. Following successful completion of negotiations, the MoPH submitted the proposed drafted contracts to SPC (Special Procurement Commission) at MoF for review and approval. SPC has approved 16 submitted contracts which are listed below. After successful completion of negotiations with qualified first rank PCH bidders, the contracts shall be awarded to the winner bidders.

Now, before MOPH signs below-listed contracts with successful bidders, in accordance with the rule 123 (1) of Rules of Procedures for public procurement of Afghan Procurement Law, the MoPH shall publish a notice of the proposed awards.

The list of proposed awards which is planned to be contracted with the winner bidders is attached to this letter.

Please note that if any individual/organizations have any issues, they have the right to submit an application for review of this decision in accordance with article 85 of the Procurement Law.

Article 85 (right to review): *“A bidder that has suffered loss due to violation of this law may seek review by submitting a written application for review identifying the specific decision, act or failure to act alleged to violate Procurement legislation”.*

Any applications for review must be submitted officially in writing to Health Economics and Financing Directorate, Great Masoud Square, Ministry of Public Health, Kabul Afghanistan, not later than 10 a.m. on Sat 17 October 2009. Late applications will not be accepted.
